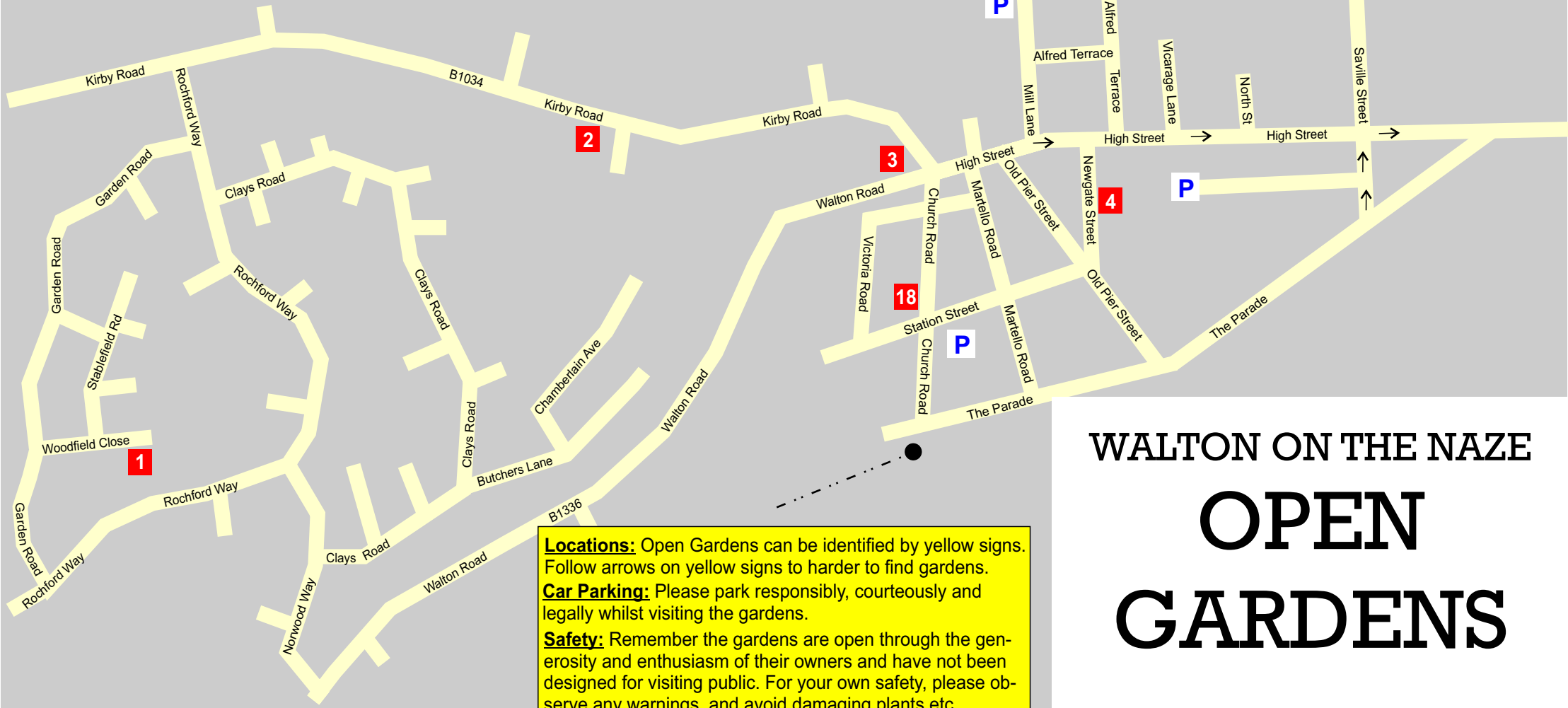


Walton on the Naze - Town End

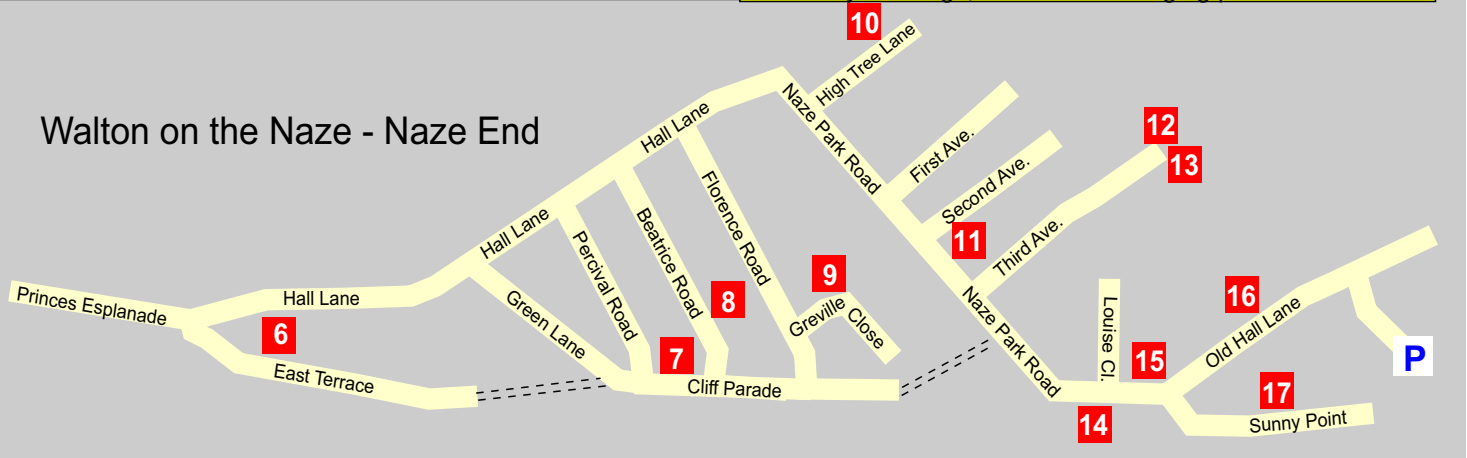
